


All about Lego Group

Lego club is a group activity where children work together to create a Lego model and develop their Speech & Language skills. The group supports with the development of social interaction skills, listening, understanding, vocabulary and spoken language.



Lego group will run at school with the support of the Speech and Language Therapist as part of Launchpad for Language. If you have any questions or would like to learn more, please speak to your school SENCo or link Speech and Language Therapist.



There are usually 3 roles in the group:

The engineer or Architect looks at the instructions, asks the supplier for piece of Lego and **communicates** to the builder where it goes.

The supplier **listens** to the engineer and then finds the right piece the engineer asks for. He gives it to the builder.

The builder **waits** for the supplier to give him the right piece, **listens** to the engineer and then builds the model.
