

Covid Home Learning Plan

QB Level 1 – school is open but some children are self-isolating

- The weekly lessons will go on to Google Classroom where all children have access in PDF form.
 - 5 x Literacy lessons
 - 5 x maths
 - 1 x Geography or History
 - 1 x Science
 - 1 x PSHE (votes for schools)
 - 5 x reading lessons
- These online resources are also available:
 - White rose Maths
 - Times table rockstars
 - SATs Companion (Year 6)
 - Espresso
 - Magic Link handwriting
 - Oak National Academy
- Printed packs are available from the office but must be requested and signed out. Failure to pick up packs on two occasions without a valid reason will mean the school will not print out packs for that family.
- Learning to take place online with no additional recorded lessons by teachers but other online videos are available (e.g. White Rose) because school is open and teachers are teaching full time.
- Vulnerable children and those on an EHCP who are self-isolating will have a weekly call from the SENDCo or Learning mentor.

QB Level 2 – school is open but large percentage (35%+) of children are absent

- Classes will be combined (e.g. one Year 5 class instead of 2) where possible, or teachers given additional PPA.
- A year group teacher will record audio to go with the lesson plans explaining what they have to do – this will not necessarily be the class teacher.
- The weekly lessons will go on to Google Classroom where all children have access in PDF form.

QB Level 3 – school is open for only for key workers (lockdown) OR a bubble has been shut down

- The weekly lessons will go on to Google Classroom where all children have access in PDF form.
 - 4 x Literacy lessons
 - 5 x maths
 - 1 x Geography or History
 - 1 x Science
 - 1 x PSHE (votes for schools)
 - 3 x reading lessons

 - Times table rockstars
 - SATs Companion (Year 6)
 - Espresso
 - Magic Link handwriting
 - Oak National Academy
- Audio to be recorded to go with Literacy, reading and Maths lessons. Online lessons will be provided by the teachers and accessed via YouTube – these will not be shared on Instagram without permission.
- Weekly Googlemeet calls (arranged safely through google classrooms) to keep class together with social and emotional focus. If the teacher is unable to come into school, a member of SMT will lead these meetings.
- Children who do not attend Googlemeet to get a fortnightly call from the class teacher.
- Class story to be recorded being read every day (KS1) and KS2 provided as a PDF along with a longer recording that can be split during the week. These recordings can be shared amongst year group staff.
- Printed packs are available from the office but must be requested and signed out. Failure to pick up packs on two occasions without a valid reason will mean the school will not print out packs for that family.
- Reading recovery to continue with selected children on google meet.
- Catch up maths to continue with selected children on google meet
- Vulnerable children to be contacted twice weekly by pastoral team.
- Children access these via Google Classrooms and are expected to hand in work via 'turn it in'. If parents have not sent in work (or sent photos via email), they will be contacted with regards to accessing work. Parents responsible as much as teachers.

*In the unlikely event that both class teachers from the year group are unwell then online lessons will be used instead of personal audio recordings.
