The aim of science teaching at Queensbridge Primary School is to ignite children's curiosity about natural phenomena and give children the necessary skills and language to explore the world around them.

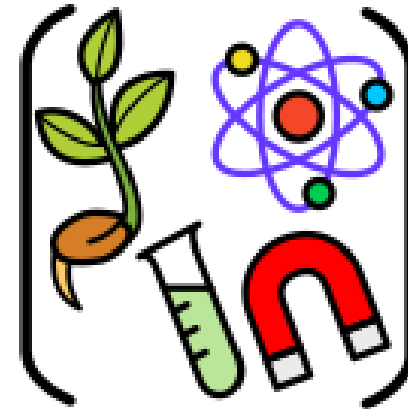
Main Principles:

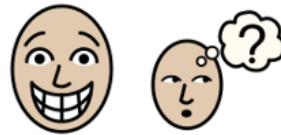

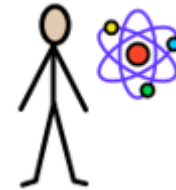

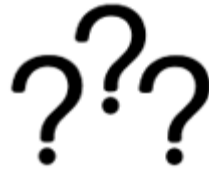
