Hello, we are the Learning Mentor Team, Caleb, Luke and Sam. We each work across different phases.

- Caleb works alongside years 5/6.
- Luke works alongside years 3/4.
- Sam works alongside Reception and years 1/2.

We support children in class who may find school a little tricky. We also run specific interventions tailored to your child's needs. An example of Interventions are:

Anger Management, Social and Emotional needs, Circle of friends, Self Esteem,

Cognitive Behaviour Therapy, Bereavement, Lego Therapy and building confidence.

We also work 1:1 with children who are feeling upset or face challenges outside of school.
